



Does playing disc golf in South Carolina in October sound really appealing? Is it your dream to play in one of the most elite tournaments ever? How about having some (or all) of your entry fee paid while going?

As the Wisconsin State Coordinator I have the task of finding a competitor that is committed to going and competing in this amazing event. Outlined below is how YOU can earn that spot and represent Wisconsin at the **2010 United States Disc Golf Championships**.

The rules are pretty simple:

- There are three (3) qualifying events this year which include the Greater Milwaukee Open (May 29), the Manitowalk in the Park (July 10), and the Mad City Open (Aug 7-8). You earn 1 point for every person you beat while competing in the Open division. You also earn point fractions for anyone you tie. We take your best 2 of 3 point earnings and the person with the most points earns the opportunity to compete at the USDGC.

- There is a one time \$25 fee which must be paid prior to earning points for this series. We do this because we only want serious competitors to apply. ALL money raised will be awarded to the winner of the series. If the amount raised exceeds the USDGC entry fee then the first \$230 will be applied to the entry and the rest will be handed to the winner.

- You must be a Wisconsin resident and must make a commitment to attend. If you back out, the money and the position will move to the second place person. You can not 'give' your spot away to the person of your choice.

- In the event of a best 2 of 3 points tie, the overall points earned for all 3 events will be the first tie breaker. If it is still tied after that there will be an 18 hole playoff between any parties tied for the 1st place spot to be completed by August 17th. The competitor with the lower PDGA number will tee first.
