

USDGC Performance Flight Qualifying

Wisconsin Representative

The Wisconsin qualifier for the USDGC Performance Flight will be based on how well the players perform compared to their rating in several Wisconsin Tour events. The best 12 round point totals will count toward the player's total score. The player with the highest total score will be awarded the USDGC invitation. The player will have one week to accept and sign up for the USDGC. If they decline or don't sign up, the invitation will be granted to the next highest finisher.

Please note a few important qualifying requirements for the USDGC Performance Flight

- Players must have a current PDGA membership
- Players must have passed the PDGA officials exam
- Players must have a PDGA player rating of 875 or higher
- Players must have a minimum of 12 PDGA rated rounds between August 1, 2014 and the last ratings report prior to the USDGC

Scoring will be based on the players rating at the time of the tournament and the PDGA ratings based on their tournament play. Below is a completely fictitious scenario showing the point totals each player would get for their performance. Since this is based on performance, all divisions can participate and anyone that meets the eligibility requirements can win.

All proceeds will be used to pay for the player's entry fee into the USDGC.

Players can sign up any time during the year. Eligible rounds are counted after payment is received. WI Tour stops scheduled between and including the Wisconsin Spring Opener on March 21 and the Mad City Open on August 15-16 will be used for points in order for the qualifier to have time to sign up.

2. Participant with the most positive point rounds out of the 12 qualifying rounds
3. Participant with the highest single round point total
4. Participant with the lower PDGA rating for their last qualifying round
